Last year we asked all Lady Captains to help raise funds for the EWGA Trust, by nominating one of their club summer stableford competitions as the 'Trust Stableford Competition'. We were delighted at the result and participating clubs raised an additional £2,950, which will be used to help girls under 21 or those in full time education with their coaching and competition expenses and essential items of equipment.

I am writing again this year to ask if you would nominate one of your summer stableford competitions to be the 'Trust Stableford Competition'

In order to find out how much money to send add up the points of the top ten scores and then multiply every point by 2p.


It will be for you and your Committee to decide how the money is raised, you may wish to charge a little more for the competition or just take it from funds. Whichever you choose it really will not cost very much (if the top ten scores average 36 points then it will only amount to a little over £7). However, if every club in England takes part, that's a lot of money for the Trust.

There will also be a further incentive; the club that scores the highest points will, at the next Annual General Meeting, win a laptop computer and receive a memento in recognition of their efforts.

Alternatively, your Committee may prefer to make a donation to the Trust and any donation will be greatly appreciated.

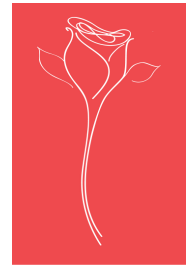

Enc: Conditions of Competition and Entry Form

EWGA TRUST STABLEFORD



Conditions of Entry

1. The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules as may be approved by the Competition Committee.
2. All female club members are eligible to play in the Trust Stableford Competition, provided they hold a CONGU Handicap. They are eligible to play in more than one competition, if a member of more than one club.
3. Clubs may play the Competition at any time before 30 September 2010.
4. The points from the top 10 scores will be added together to make a points total.
5. The points total will be multiplied by 2p per point to find the amount to be paid to the Trust.
6. The completed form and cheque, to be sent to the EWGA Head Office, by 31 October 2010.
7. The club with the most stableford points from the top 10 scores will become the Trust Club Stableford winner and receive a memento in recognition of its contribution.
8. In the event of a draw the result will be decided on a count back of points on the last 6/3/1 holes and then front 6/3/1 holes if a winner has not been established
9. The decision of the Trust Management Committee will be final.
